3 **SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL**
4 **JUNE 14, 2022**

5 The City Council of the City of Newport, Arkansas met in special session Tuesday June 14,
6 2022 in the boardroom of City Hall.

7
8 Mayor Stewart called the meeting to order. City Clerk/Treasurer Hembrey called the roll.
9 Council members present were Carol Falwell, Kathy Green, Regina Lake, Leroy Manko,
10 Andy May and Julie Moss. City Attorney John Pettie was present. Council Members
11 Michael Allen and Donny Ivie were absent.

13 Mayor Stewart stated the reason for the special meeting was to consider street repairs with
14 funding from the Street Department and funds released from ARPA funds. Mayor Stewart
15 stated that Hawkeye Enterprises, Inc. had called and stated that asphalt prices were
16 increasing approximately 10% each week. Mayor Stewart stated he called this meeting to
17 consider approving the attached list of street repairs in order to lock in the current price
18 before any other increases occur. Mayor Stewart stated the project at current prices would be
19 \$229,429.00. After discussion, a motion by May and a second by Green to appropriate funds
20 from the Street Fund and ARPA funds to fund Hawkeye Enterprises, Inc. to repair:

22 1. Village Drive to Cross Street, approx., 11,700 sq. ft.
23 2. McClarty Street to North State Street, approx., 34,750 sq. ft.
24 3. Beard Street to Phillips Street approx., 8,140 sq. ft.
25 4. State Street south of Daugherty Street, approx., 1,650 sq. ft.
26 5. Daugherty Street east of State Street, approx., 32,280 sq. ft.
27 6. Daugherty Street west of State Street approx., 26,884 sq. ft.
28 7. Melody Lane, east first 350 ft.

30 The motion carried (6/0) with “yes” votes by Green, May, Falwell, Lake, Moss and Manko.

32 With no further business before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
